CRUISE REPORT - USCGC *Spar*

7-9 May 1975

Cruise Objective: Deploy mooring #GBK1 on the southwest part of Georges Bank.

The ship departed South Portland, Maine at 1300 on 7 May 1975, and arrived on station (40°-51' N/67°-25' W) at 0600 on 8 May 1975. Mooring #GBK1 was deployed with 3 VACMs and one FILM CM at 0930. Two surface buoys (without instruments) were deployed to bracket the subsurface mooring to protect it from fishing operations.

The ship returned to South Portland at 0830 on 9 May 1975.


